No more counting paper ballots. No more specific voting locations. Your students can vote wherever they want, using any internet-connected device—and saving your staff a lot of time and stress.

Customized and secure ballots, increased voter turnout, and confident delivery of results

Validated eligibility

Define eligible voters and restrict participation in certain elections. You can also control visibility of entire ballots based on eligibility lists.

Secure and confidential voting

Protect voter anonymity by separating votes cast from user identification. Unduplicated, verified, and secret ballots will ensure private and secure elections.

Increased participation

Display an alert on the system homepage as soon as the election is active and voting is open. To ensure access, you can create a unique URL specific to each election and then post or link to ballots within other campus systems and on websites as well as through social media.

Comprehensive voter education

Upload candidate bios, platforms, and photos so students can review their choices before casting a vote. You can even include information about candidates and referendum measures right in the ballot.

Real-time polling and winner projections

Rely on a secure process that collects and automatically tallies votes, offering real-time polling and winner projections based on the majority vote.

Targeted ballots

Use different types of questions on ballots, including single or multiple choice, ranking, and write-ins. You can also sequence multiple ballots and eligibility lists for customized ballots.

Transparent reporting and historical records

Easily export voting results to a spreadsheet format for analysis or public posting. You can also archive past or completed elections to create an official historical archive of ballots and results.
